
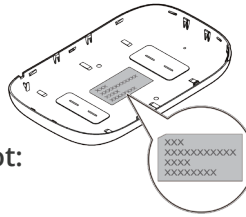


Welcome! We are happy to have you as a new customer!

Getting started

Your SIM card is already in your 3G hotspot and is ready to use! Once arrived at your travel destination, you can access the internet by following these steps:

- 1 Take the back cover off. **Put the battery** in the device.
- 2 **Press and hold the**  **button** until the indicator lights up, signifying that the Wi-Fi hotspot is turned on
- 3 **Connect your laptop/tablet/phone with Wi-Fi hotspot:**
 - ▶ Switch the Wi-Fi "ON".
 - ▶ Select the Transatel network.
- 4 **Enter the Wi-Fi password** printed on the back cover of your Wi-Fi hotspot.
- 5 **Create your account to check your balance and recharge your SIM card.**
Use your hotspot's Wi-Fi network:
 - ▶ Open your My DataSIM app and fill in your information.

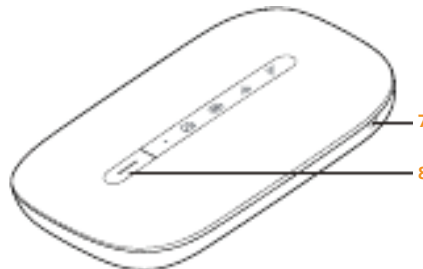
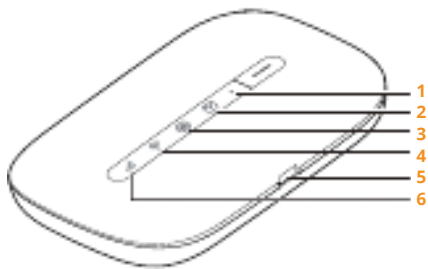

Appearance



1 Power indicator

Blinks slowly: The Wi-Fi hotspot enters standby mode.

2 Messages indicator

Green: New message.
Blinking green: Inbox full.

3 Battery indicator

Green: Sufficient battery.
Blinking green: Charging the battery.
Red: Low battery.

4 Wi-Fi indicator

Green: Wi-Fi turned on.
Blue: Connected to WLAN.


5 Micro USB port

6 Signal indicator

Green: Strong signal.
Orange: Weak signal.
Red: No signal.

7 Lanyard hole

8 Power button

Press and hold the  button to turn the Wi-Fi hotspot on or off.
